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Taking care of your Sewer Network in Pittenweem – Project Update.

Important Scottish Water Information

We are investing in and upgrading the sewer network to help reduce sewer flooding and protect the local environment. This newsletter is to provide a further update on progress as we continue the sewer improvement works and head towards the final phases of our work in East Shore.

Update:

East Shore Works: The main works along East Shore are near completion and the fencing and traffic management from this area has been removed.

There are some minor works we still require to do at each of the 2 manholes (at No18 and No5 East Shore Approx). This is to change the flows from the existing network to the new CSO (Approx 2 days' work with minor and localised traffic management). However, this cannot be done until the work on the new outfall is completed.

Outfall Works: Unfortunately, the work to complete the new outfall pipe has been delayed. Weather conditions has meant we have been unable to get the Barge to Pittenweem Harbour. The Barge is required to allow us to construct the remaining outfall pipe in the outer harbour.

We hope to have this in place from around 6th July which will allow the outfall works to resume.

Updated Timeline:

Subject to the barge arriving at the Harbour, the outfall works are planned to resume from 5th July and expected to be completed within 2 weeks.

Following the completion of the outfall, we will then complete the connection to the existing sewer network and the abandonment of the existing overflow pipes at both East Shore and The Gyles.

We hope to have all works completed by **26th July 2024**

Pittenweem Arts Festival:

We remain committed to being clear of all our working areas in advance of the festival and we are continuing to liaise with the arts festival organisers regarding our remaining work.
